The course was fully featured and well structured. I would easily recommend this course to others who need/want to learn about this topic.

Q3

What things can be improved in the training?

There was a 3-5 second lag between what was shown on screen versus the audio, so when moving between applications, multiple tabs and code to trace issues in the later sessions. It would be "you'll see here then we go here and you'll see....", but actually we are seeing two 'navigations' behind. Strangely enough, the mouse cursor was in sync with the audio though, so we'd see you highlight the area by wiggling the mouse, but it'd be over the incorrect section due to the video delay.

Recommend that when moving between App, tabs, etc when tracing that this potential delay is taken into account. I say potential as this may have been a one-off issue.

Including Garbage collector differences, as not all behave the same which can impact the decision process as to which to use. I.E. some are multithread CG, some compress when moving to Old GEN, some can't do both (e.g. parallel, CMS, G1) and perhaps talking about tenuring thresholds. Including these aspects briefly would see this course being the definitive course for JAVA Performance to send staff on.
